Dear residents of Brynyffynnon

Over the last week a network of street and estate co-ordinators has been set-up throughout the ward of Brynyffynnon, which I encourage everyone to support as best they can by registering as a “neighbourly buddy” with your street co-ordinator, who will in turn link you up with a neighbour who is self-isolating because of age, health or has contracted COVID19.

The role of the buddy is to offer to shop for essential groceries, collect medication from local pharmacies and to keep in phone contact with those neighbours who are facing loneliness due to being self-isolated.

A Facebook Group for each of the estates has been set-up as a way for only the residents of that street to join, which will minimise the opportunity for scammers to take advantage of our vulnerable neighbours.

We currently have a small supply of blue disposable gloves for volunteers to use when out on an neighbourly errand.

Dear residents of Hirwaun

Hello. If you are already self-isolating (or about to) then we want to help.

Offa Community Council members and staff are co-ordinating help for the most vulnerable residents living in the Offa area.

Do you currently have family and friends who can help you with:

Food shopping, topping up your utility bill cards, collecting prescriptions/medicine, walking your dog, posting mail.

If **Yes** then please continue to rely on your family and friends until such time that they themselves are having to self-isolate.

The information we need from you: Your name, address, contact tel no's, email address and your reason for self isolating - aged 70 or over, under-lying health issues or both.

We can only help with the assistance of community minded neighbours

Would you be prepared to act as the Hirwaun street co-ordinator? If so please contact Phil Wynn.

If you are currently free of the symptoms of coronavirus and you feel comfortable with helping your fellow neighbours that have followed government advice to self-isolate (due to age or poor health) then we are gathering details of those living on Hirwaun who wish to help as a neighbourly buddy.

To register as a volunteer please contact **Phil Wynn**, details are as above.

Coronavirus is contagious and has already resulted in the death of a Wrexham resident. Please take every precaution to ensure you are only spreading kindness. Avoid physical contact by keeping a 2 metre separation from others, wash your hands regularly for at least 20 seconds and follow the national News for daily guidance on what we all need to do to minimise the spread of the virus.
