Dear Residents of Hermitage

If you are self-isolating (or about too) then I and colleagues of Offa Community Council are here to help. Members and staff are coordinating help for the most vulnerable residents living in the Offa area.

Do you currently have family and friends that can help you with:

- Food shopping
- Top up utility bills
- Pharmacy collections
- Posting mail etc.

If yes, please continue to rely on your family and friends until such times they themselves are having to self-isolate.

If no, please contact myself at the contact details I have provided and I shall endeavour to provide assistance for you.

The information that is needed from you are name, address, contact details, the reasons for self-isolating, aged 70 or older stating your underlying health issues or both.

If you are free of the symptoms of Coronavirus and feel comfortable with helping your neighbours which have followed government advice to self-isolate (due to age and health reasons) Offa are gathering details of people living in Hermitage who wish to help as a friend.

Coronavirus is contagious and has already resulted in the death of a Wrexham lady. Please take every precaution and to refrain from contact with others and avoid contact by keeping a separation of 2 metres from others, always wash your hands when preparing food and using door handles etc. Follow the national news for daily guidance on what is needed to do to minimise the spread of the virus.
